Tournament rules

1. The tournament will be run according to the rules of Squash South Africa and the WSF.
2. It is obligatory for players to mark/referee the match following their match. The first match of each fixture will be marked/refereed by the no 1 player of the teams. Captains are asked to make sure that players are available for this.
3. The format of play is 2 minutes warmup 18 minutes nonstop play
4. Playing order is 3,4,5,2,1
5. Balls to be used: Black double dot as supplied by the tournament organisers.
6. Leave balls on court after matches. After final fixture for the day the organisers will collect the balls from the courts.
7. Count all points. The player with the most points wins the match and is awarded 2 match points. If 2 players should draw, each is awarded 1 match point.
8. At end of fixture the match points for the 2 teams are added and the team with the most points will be awarded 4 bonus points. If 2 teams should draw on match points, each team will be awarded 2 points.
9. Scorecards are to be handed in at the designated area or to the designated person upon completion of the fixture.
10. After the first fixture team playing orders can be changed, but playing order is to remain the same from the second fixture onwards.
11. The only clothing requirement for this tournament is that the appropriate squash footwear be worn.
12. Decisions on disputes and behaviour during the tournament will be made by the Tournament referee. Any decision of the tournament referee will be final.
